Last Week

Our speaker last week, introduced by Chuck Anderson, was our very own Charlie Rogers with some interesting facts about the Rotary Foundation. Rotary Foundation month is November. It was founded in 1917. It was started with \$26.50, leftover from the previous years convention donated by Arch Klumph our 6th Rotary International president. Their motto is "Doing Good in the World." So far our club has donated \$500,000 to the Rotary Foundation. For 14 years we have had a four-star rating. Currently 89% of every dollar donated goes to charity events. In 2016 and 2017 we received the Outstanding Foundation Award. The Rotary Foundation is the back bone and life blood of Rotary International, giving a hand up, not a hand out. Charlie said, "Give until it feels good. If \$100 doesn't make you feel good, then give \$1,000." Polio is the first major disease since the small pox. Polio Plus was started by the Foundation in 1985. There were 350,000 cases world wide and currently there are just 29 reported cases. Charlie said. "I'd like to thank Derek Pontlitz and Chris Cassella for what they have been doing to help those whose homes have been destroyed in Fort Myers. There are miles and miles of utter destruction." Past Rotary International President Herb Brown will be turning 100 next year. They are working on a water project in Honduras in his name. The next trip will be in March. 




