He had a passion for it. He had the mentality of "I had to be better than any one else on the team." He ran 2 1/2 miles in 12 minutes. Grant said, "It takes dedication and determination to follow your goals. You need passion and love of the game and the need to be the best. Believe in

yourself" In 2007 he signed on with the Tampa Bay Devil Rays and they changed the name taking out 'Devil' and he went on to pitch in the World Series in 2008. He loved throwing fastballs and sliders. He is now 37 years old, retired and enjoying watching his girls grow up.

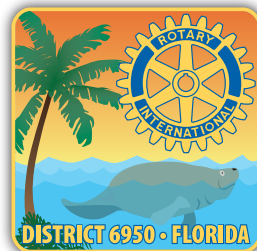

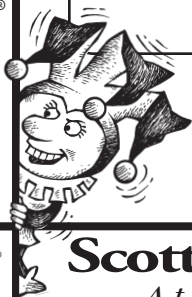

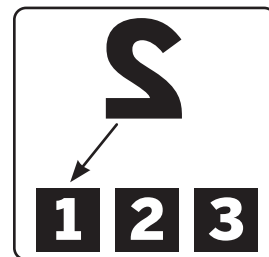
