Mission Statement

Wheelchair Foundation is a nonprofit organization leading an international effort to create awareness of the needs and abilities of people with physical disabilities, to promote the joy of giving, create global friendship, and to deliver a wheelchair to every child, teen and adult in the world who needs one, but cannot afford one. For these people, Wheelchair Foundation delivers Hope, Mobility and Independence.



Wheelchair Foundation is a division of Behring Global Educational Foundation. It is a 501(c)3 charitable foundation and the Federal Tax ID is 94-3353881.

How many people need wheelchairs but cannot afford one?

It is estimated that at least 100 million children, teens and adults worldwide need a wheelchair but cannot afford one. Some international organizations believe that the number could be as high as 6% of the population of developing countries. For instance, the number in Angola is 20% of population of 12 million people.

What is the goal of Wheelchair Foundation?

Our goal is to distribute 1 million wheelchairs in the next 5 years, and to further the awareness that a wheelchair is no longer an unaffordable item for delivery in developing countries throughout the world.
