Jill Dooling lives outside Philadelphia PA half the year and in Sanibel the other six months. Born and raised in Lancaster County PA, home of the Amish/Pennsylvania Dutch, and no she is not Amish, she moved to the Philadelphia area 30 years ago. She had vacationed in Sanibel for 25 years and then decided 16 years ago to buy a house here on Sand Dollar Drive.

She has a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology and put that to good use with her first job out of college as a Juvenile Probation and Parole Officer. She did that for ten years and decided to make a career move.

Jill now, and has been, a senior healthcare executive with more than 30 years of experience in medical device sales. She serves as Vice President of Strategic Accounts at Vapotherm. Her past experiences were in Senior Leadership positions at Covidien and Medtronic.

In her role, Jill is responsible for working with large health systems across the country overseeing contract and pricing negotiations, developing strategic sales programs and is responsible for the company sales team's leadership and sales training. Jill has worked diligently to bring double digit revenue growth to all the medical device companies she has represented.

As a leader for many years in a male dominated medical device industry, Jill saw the need for more women to be represented. Women were not entering med device sales and not raising their hand for higher roles. She formed what is called the "WLG" Women's Leadership Group. The program is for women leaders to be championed and developed through building awareness and fostering an inclusive culture. Jill led this group on a volunteer basis for the past fifteen years.

Jill volunteers as a Mentor in the Med Exec National Women's Group. This female group is comprised of VP and above senior leaders from Fortune 100 companies all over the country with the mission of increasing education on diversity and inclusion.

Jill is a member of the Women's Business Connection of Chester Co PA. A group that provides leadership development to young women starting out in business.

Jill "semi-retired" in January 2023. She is working one day a week in her current position to transition her replacement. With no more airplanes, conference calls and meetings she wanted to use her extra time to "give back". That is what brought her to the Sanibel-Captiva Rotary group and to SCCF where she hopes to get more involved and meet new people. She will be a "Snowtarian" and give as much time as she can.

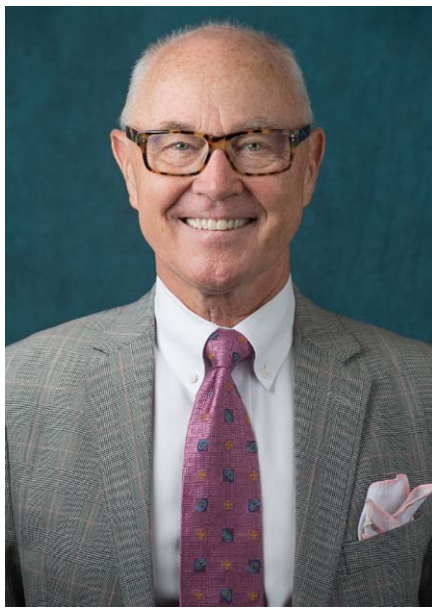

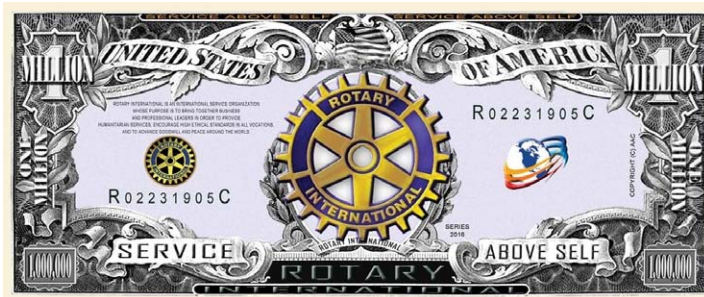
