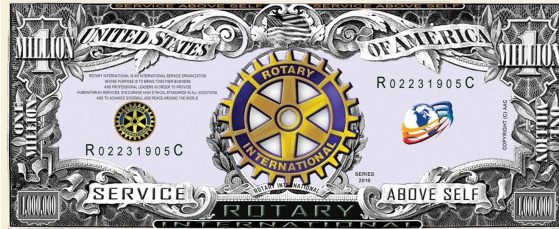

She founded the organization in 2000, and has grown it to provide over 400,000 service hours annually to at-risk kids and their families.

Kathryn was named a SWFL "Power Woman"™ by Florida Weekly. She was a News-Press "Person the Year"™ finalist in 2012, and won their Trailblazer Award in 2016. She was awarded the Women in Business "Apex Award"™ in 2014. In 2017, Kathryn was named MAKERS: Women Who Make SWFL by WGCU, and recently won the FACE Diversity Award presented by "Latinos and Gulfshore Business Magazine."

Kathryn is a 5th generation Floridian and is an avid scuba diver and spear fisherman. She has won many competitions for spear fishing, lobstering, and underwater photography.

She is past-President of the Rotary Club of Fort Myers South.
