David was born in Bellefonte, PA and grew up in State College, PA, which is home to the Pennsylvania State University and the Nittany Lions. He was interested in the Sciences at an early age, encouraged by his parents who quickly discovered that a bedroom is not appropriate lab space – he soon got a bench in the basement. He was also active in sports, lettering in football and tennis. He attended Penn State University, receiving BS a Chemistry in 1974 and an MS in Fuel Science in 1979.

In 1981, he joined the Combustion Group at the United Technologies Research Center located in East Hartford, CT. His early work as a Research Scientist involved the vaporization and mixing characteristics of fuels for jet engines. He was one of the first people to use planar laser light scattering to quantify turbulent mixing in aircraft gas turbine combustors. His expertise is measurement and characterization of gaseous and particulate emissions from combustion sources.

the Sanibel Office President of the Sanibel Captiva Trust Company.

His topic will be about - "Completing the Six Major Marathons of the World After Conquering Cancer"



Jeff Muddell oversees the daily operations of the Sanibel office and its departments and interacts with local nonprofit and city leaders about the role of The Trust Company within the community. Most recently he served as System Director of Gift Planning for the Lee Health Foundation in Fort Myers, where he led strategic planning and management of the fundraising initiative. Earlier, Jeff spent 18 years in the Orlando area, where he led fundraising efforts at Orlando Health Foundation; served as Vice President at Pace Center for Girls, and Senior Fundraising Consultant at Winkler Group. During his time in the nonprofit sector, Jeff developed an acute understanding of the unique needs of wealthy multi-generational families. He holds a Master's in Business Administration from the University of Florida's Warrington School of Business and is in the process of earning his Certified Financial Planner (CFP) designation. He earned his bachelor's degree in Communications from the University of Miami and began his professional career in broadcasting and journalism.
