### **District Disaster Trailer**

Last Friday many of our members donated Happy Bucks to a call for financial support to purchase supplies for the Disaster Response trailers headquartered in our district. We raised in excess of \$800.00! Past President John Danner has been appointed to the 2022-2023 District 6960 Disaster Response Committee and will be providing more information about the effort. Over the past few years our district has assembled a set of Disaster Response Resources to support our communities in event of a major disaster such as a hurricane, flooding, fire, or other situation. The trailers and other resources will be available to our local Rotary clubs and their communities on an as needed basis to support post disaster community needs. These are not First Responder resources but are intended to provide support following a disaster.

The resources include the following components:

- Two 18 ft box trailers outfitted with tools, such as chainsaws, large fans, generators, hand tools, personal protective gear, and supplies to assist in post disaster cleanup efforts.

One Reverse Osmosis Potable Water generator trailer and water storage and distribution stations. Trailer has the capacity to produce up to 2,000 gallons of

Payment Type - Place an R and Rotary will come up, select ROTARY

- Fill in Driver's License number
  Tag/Plate if you already have a vanity plate then enter your 5 letters and/or digits. If not enter12345
  Under Cardholder Information, enter all information then complete all Payment Information for your credit card
- Hit CONTINUE
- If screen gives you an error message go to the red indicator on screen, fix the error and click CONTINUE again
- You next screen will ask you to review and confirm, click CONFIRM and SUBMIT Your next screen is your receipt no need to PRINT as you will get a confirmation by email within minutes

Next you will receive a certificate by snail mail. Put it where you will remember where it is when your tag comes up for renewal (i.e. place in your glove compartment).
