Debra Mathinos, Ed. D., M.S.; Chief Programs Officer Dr. Mathinos has over 40 years of experience in the field of education working as a teacher, university professor and district level administrator. She has extensive experience working with at-risk and exceptional students, as well as those with economic disadvantages and English language learners. Her goal is to see all children succeed and grow into young adults with an abundance of opportunities available to them.

Her areas of curricular expertise include project-based learning initiatives, STEM -focused integrated instructional programs, and Career/School to Work programs. She is certified as a teaching professional and administrator in Florida, Pennsylvania, and Rhode Island. Dr. Mathinos designed the instructional program for the Harlem Heights Community Charter School and currently serves as principal of the Charter School.

In addition to her work with children, Dr. Mathinos develops and delivers educational programs for children and adults at The Heights Center.



- Under My Bills:
 - Payment Type Place an R and Rotary will come up, select ROTARY
 - Fill in Driver's License number
 - o Tag/Plate if you already have a vanity plate then enter your 5 letters and/or digits. If not enter12345
- · Under Cardholder Information, enter all information then complete all Payment Information for your credit card
- Hit CONTINUE
- If screen gives you an error message go to the red indicator on screen, fix the error and click CONTINUE again
- You next screen will ask you to review and confirm, click CONFIRM and SUBMIT
- Your next screen is your receipt no need to PRINT as you will get a confirmation by email within minutes

Next you will receive a certificate by snail mail. Put it where you will remember where it is when your tag comes up for renewal (i.e. place in your glove compartment).
