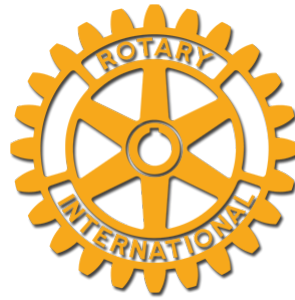

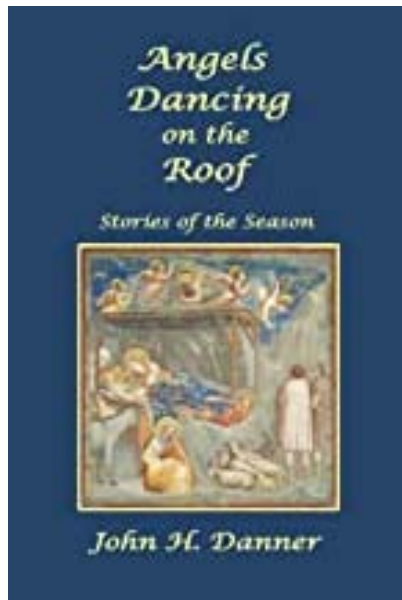

**This coming week we will be hearing from Julie Boudreaux, Chief Executive Officer of the Children's Advocacy Center (CAC)**



Julie joined Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) in December 2018 and transitioned to CEO in March 2019. She is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker with a Bachelor's degree in Social Work from Penn State University and a Master's degree in Social Work from Temple University. Prior to joining CAC, Julie was a Program Manager for Lee County Human and Veteran Services for 12 years. She managed programs working with youth in the juvenile justice system, neighborhood revitalization, and the homeless continuum of care. Julie previously worked for 14 years at SalusCare, where she managed several programs for children and families, including behavioral health and child welfare services, working her way up to Director of Family Services. Julie has been a part of numerous committees to enhance services in our community, including developing the Lee County Task Force on Hoarding. Julie is originally from Pennsylvania and has lived and worked in Lee County for over 30 years. She is married with four children.

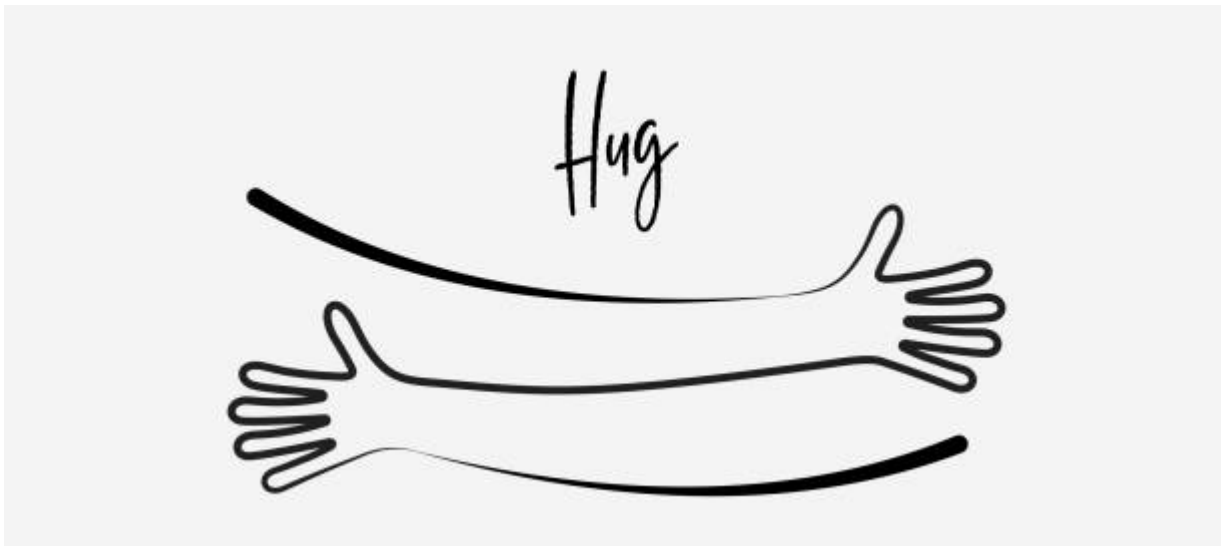
