INVESTMENT IN THE FUTURE

7he Riverview IB Class of 2024 E2 program has demonstrated remarkable success and impact. With 26 dedicated students, supported by 3 highly trained E2 mentors, the program has provided a substantial 510 hours of direct mentorship and coaching. This intensive support has yielded impressive results, with the class collectively earning \$3,703,300 in accepted university scholarships, averaging \$142,434 per student. The program also addresses financial barriers, allocating \$30,000 through the Last Mile Fund to ease the transition into university. Notably, 77% of the students are minorities, and 85% are first-generation college attendees, all of whom qualify for free or reduced lunch. Demonstrating the program's success, 100% of these students are set to attend college or university in the fall of 2024. This achievement underscores the effectiveness and necessity of targeted mentorship and financial support in fostering academic and future success for underrepresented students. 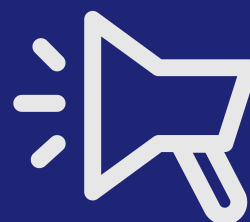
Main Entrance

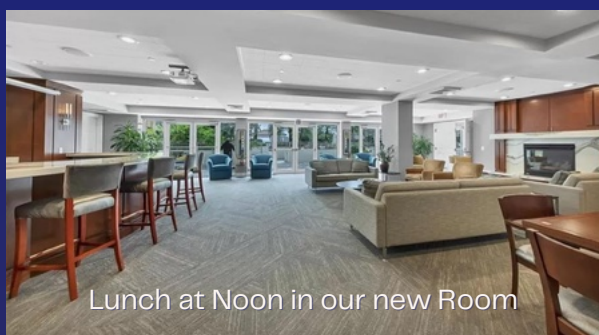
Parking

NexTrex Recycling Challenge

THE CLUB HAS ACCEPTED THE CHALLENGE - START SAVING YOUR PLASTIC BAGS!

How does the challenge work?

- Register on NexTrex.com to obtain access to the Trex Portal
- Determine a 12-month collection time period
- Collect a minimum of 1,000 lbs.
- Report recycling totals at my.trex.com

- Weigh, record and attached pictures
- Deliver the collected plastic film to a participating retailer (see list) for recycling

Stores prefer smaller and more frequent amounts in the provided bin. Please contact store ahead of time with larger amounts.

What does Trex provide?

- Up to three recycling bins
- Posters
