Tim Crosby, a native of Augusta, he shared highlights from the inception to current status of this iconic location. The

Masters was the brainchild of legendary amateur golfer Bobby Jones and investment dealer Clifford Roberts, who co-founded the Augusta National Golf Club in 1933. The

original architect was Alister MacKenzie, a British surgeon who later became a golf course architect. When the tournament began it was called the Augusta National Invitation Tournament. Roberts suggested it



be called the

Masters, a reference to the "masters of golf" who played in it, but Jones thought the name was immodest. Roberts finally got his way in 1939. Rory got his way too with a Grand Slam win! What a great finish...Thank you *Tim* for sharing such a rich history!
