**Troy Smith** is entering his 11th year as a volunteer and has been the chairman of the general parking, ecology, commissary, VIP parking, benefactor and volunteer shuttle committees. He is a partner at the Burr & Forman law firm, where he is a member of its construction and project development practice group. He was recently named one of the top lawyers in America for construction law and is a Florida Trend Legal Elite attorney.

He graduated from the University of Florida and received his law degree from Stetson. Smith is on the board of the Palmer Catholic Academy, has served on the boards of Learn to Read Jacksonville, the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation and was president of the Jacksonville Bar Association's Young Lawyers Division and president of the Jacksonville Bar. He and his wife Jenni have six children.

**Jared Rice** and his staff are charged with selling tickets, corporate chalets and other hospitality venues, providing dining and merchandising venues throughout the golf course property and working closely with the volunteer leadership to help give fans the best possible experience from the time they drive into the parking lots to the time they leave. Since Rapp became executive director in 2010, The Players has become as much a world-class event as a world-class golf tournament. Rapp and his team,

which included Rice from day one, de-emphasized the issue of whether The Players should be considered a "major championship" (joining the Masters, U.S. Open, British Open and PGA Championship) and instead focused on making The Players a combination of sports and social event similar to the Kentucky Derby or Daytona's Speedweeks.

Rice, a native of Portsmouth, N.H., and a graduate of the University of South Carolina, was hired by Rapp from the Tour's business development and global licensing department, where he worked for four years. Prior to coming to Ponte Vedra Beach, Rice worked for the Detroit Red Wings of the National Hockey League, and before that with the Walt Disney Company, where he was in marketing and sales positions for the Ducks and the Angels.
