LTG (ret) Michael Linnington serves as chief executive officer of Wounded Warrior Project (WWP). He brings 35 years of military experience and leadership to the organization. Linnington oversees day to-day operations and works with the leadership team to set and implement the organization's strategic vision. He is responsible for ensuring WWP's free programs and services continue to have the greatest possible impact on the warriors,

caregivers, and families we serve. Prior to joining WWP, Linnington was the first permanent Director of the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency, following a 35-year career as a Soldier. Throughout his career in the Army, Linnington served in a variety of command and staff positions, included Brigade Command of the 3rd Brigade of the 101st Airborne Division (in both

Iraq and Afghanistan), Commanding General, Military District of Washington/Joint Force Headquarters-National Capital Region, and Military Deputy for the Under Secretary of Personnel and Readiness. Linnington received his commission from the US Military Academy at West Point (1980) and has a MS in Applied Mathematics from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and National Security Strategy from the National War College. He is married with 2 adult children, and 2 grandchildren.



Tim Crosby joined K9s For Warriors in 2016 and currently manages development and stewardship of corporate supporters. Tim also plays a


