securing and growing Rotary programs throughout the world.

Thank you Andre! Jarrett Dreicer, VP of Baptist Medical Center shared the important role Beaches Baptist plays in and around our beach community. Jarrett was joined by Dr. Brian Dalton, a

surgeon at Baptist presented to the club information about robotic hernia repair. Robotic hernia repair is performed as a minimally invasive procedure, meaning, only tiny incisions are required.

A small camera is inserted through the incision to allow the surgeon to visualize the internal structures while carrying out the hernia repair. Hernia repair

surgery is typically performed under general anesthesia and may use either a robotic or laparoscopic approach.
