Dr. Conway's personal experiences and relentless research combined with his role as a clinical research scientist practitioner, would earn him the credentials and reputation as a sought-after expert, scholar and advocate in the field of neuro developmental disorders which includes dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, and a myriad of other learning disorders. Dr. Conway continues to expand these innovative, evidence- and research- based programs through the Morris Centers. The centers provide an intensive transdisciplinary approach to the assessment and successful treatment of dyslexia the treatments implemented at the Morris Centers are remediating dyslexic in a matter of months, not years.
