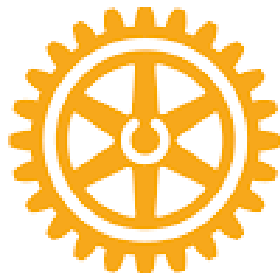

They help improve skills of children and adults who have difficulty with school or job success, e.g. poor reading, spelling, comprehension, writing, speech, math, sensory processing attention, behavior or social skills. Uniquely, The Morris Center uses a transdisciplinary team of caring professionals, individually tailored assess-



ment and treatment, and a scientifically proven treatment program. This program makes long-term improvements of weak skills that may cause academic or job difficulties. Dr. Morris is also the co-founder of the Einstein School in Gainesville. A charter school established to serve students with learning difficulties in reading, writing, speech and/or language.
