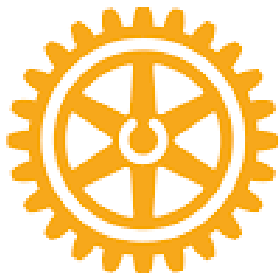

Amanda Lamosova is a photographer from St. Augustine, and previous Rotary Exchange student to Kosice, Slovakia in 2007. Lamosova first started helping with the Ukrainian refugee crisis in March and recently returned from a second trip in July to continue with the effort.

She has met with numerous nonprofits in charge of delivering goods to Ukraine and relocating Ukrainian families to other countries. Lamosova has also helped raise over 300 pounds of diapers, school supplies, and other essential items in America to donate to refugee centers when she goes back to Slovakia and Ukraine. During her first trip she translated for Disaster Aid Europe and delivered water filters to Ukraine while also creating an inner dialog between nonprofits in Slovakia.

Lamosova's goal now is to spread firsthand information and experiences to help raise awareness about the refugee crisis that is still a widespread problem being faced in Ukraine.
