In early 2000, the foster care system in Florida was struggling to provide the nurturing care and developmental support children needed to overcome the loss, grief and trauma caused by family crises. Statistics were beginning to demonstrate widespread failures of

the Foster Care system where children continue to disruptively move from placement to placement.



Seamark Ranch has worked to change the face of childcare for the fortunate ones who find their home at Seamark Ranch. Seamark is the solution to the increasing need to help children

who, through no fault of their own, have been left alone in this world. Since opening their doors- Seamark has served over 100 children with it's homes, on-campus school and extensive childcare programs.

Next up was Lori Richards, ED of BEAM. Founded in 1985 by representatives of local churches who received many

personal appeals for emergency financial assistance, The Beaches Emergency Assistance Ministry, or BEAM, was created to provide help in a coordinated way and to prevent duplication of services. Today the community support for BEAM has extended well beyond the faith community to include individuals, businesses, local organizations, and local foundations. They rely heavily on community support to assist their neighbors in times of need. To prevent homelessness,

we provide emergency assistance to cover overdue rent and utility payments. Currently, their food bank need to be replenished so TBRCITW is partnering for a 30 day food drive beginning September 15th through Thursday, October 13th. Please see the attached for list of much need items!

He is often asked to speak to audiences of public, private, and non-profit sector executives and professionals on strategies for success in the 21st century. He teaches the principles, strategies, and skills of effectively leading and managing change. Optimizing organizational performance is the focus of his advising, teaching, and research. He received his Bachelor of Arts Degree and Master of Arts Degree both in Political Science from the University of Florida. He earned his law degree from the Florida State University College of Law. He received his Master of Science Degree in Criminal Justice and his

Ph.D. in Public Affairs from the University of Central Florida.

As a professor of public administration at Flagler College, he taught over a dozen different courses in leadership, management, and public policy instructing several hundred working professionals and executives serving in 50-60 different public, private, and non-profit sector organizations across Northeast and Central Florida. He is also a co-founder and faculty member of the Flagler County Leadership Academy and the Putnam County Sheriff's Leadership Academy, executive education programs for local officials. He often conducts training on a wide range of topics involving leadership, management, and organizational performance for private and public sector and non-profit entities. He has overseen studies and research for a number of clients. Dr. Saviak has co-authored several articles, a textbook, and research involving public-private partnerships (P3s) and transportation policy and co-authored a guide for state and local officials on contracting and P3s.
