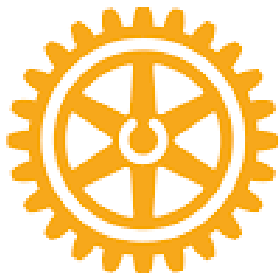

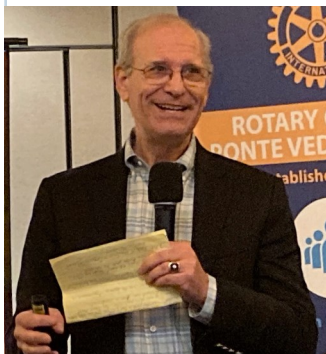

If you missed us last week we congratulated **Dr. Wayne Gordon** on being named our Rotarian of the month for December. Congrats Wayne! We had a very special presentation last week by Rabbi Jack Romberg. Imagine a German Jew who was a decorated German soldier in World War I, a resister in Cologne at the start of Hitler's reign of terror, and a Silver Star decorated U.S. Army soldier. Three heroic actions, at three different times, in three different places. This is



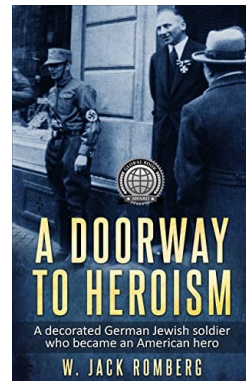
the story of Richard Stern, whose photograph of his protest hangs in multiple German museums, showing a rare Jewish protest in Nazi Germany. This man was Rabbi Jack's great uncle. Richard Stern's history connected to the Holocaust is unique. This book tells his full story along with how the Shoah impacted his family. "It is good to bring the story of Richard Stern to English speaking readers" says Romberg, about a man who is respected across Germany for his willingness to stand tall against cruel

discrimination. "Many people have reason to be proud of a man who served both his countries and his own conscience."

LT Susan Mitchell was born in Westminster, CA on Jun 7, 1978. Upon completion of basic recruit training in 2003 she attended Electronics Technician "A" School in Great Lakes, IL. Her first duty assignment was onboard USS JOHN C STENNIS (CVN 74) in Bremerton, WA from 2004-2008. While onboard USS JOHN C STENNIS she earned her CSOOW, ESWS, and EAWS qualifications as well as being meritoriously advanced to Petty Officer Second Class. She next served as Recruiter in Charge at Navy Recruiting District San Diego from 2009-2011 and earned meritorious advancement to Petty Officer First Class in 2010. She reported to USS MUSTIN (DDG 89) stationed in Yokosuka, Japan from 2011-2013 where she earned her CSC and AAWC qualifications and was promoted to Chief Petty Officer in 2012. She next reported to USS LASSEN (DDG 82) in 2013 stationed in Yokosuka, Japan where she was selected for the Limited Duty Officer Program. Upon earning her commission in 2014 and attending CSO track in Dahlgren, VA, she reported to USS CHANCELLORSVILLE (CG 62) stationed in Yokosuka, Japan from 2014-2019 as EMO where she earned her SWO, TAO, FTAO, FAAWC, and CDO qualifications. She then reported to USS PHILIPPINE SEA (CG 68) stationed in Mayport, FL from 2019-2021 as EMO. Lastly, she reported to SCSTC DETACHMENT SOUTHEAST in 2021 as the Combat Systems Officer at the Waterfront Facility. Her personal decorations include Marine Corps Commendation Medal (five awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (five awards), various unit and campaign awards. LT Mitchell is married to CWO2 Daniel Mitchell stationed onboard USS LASSEN. They reside in Callahan, FL.

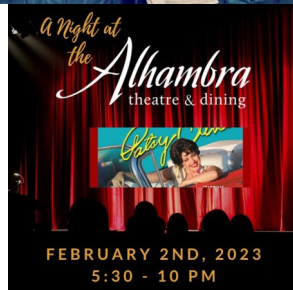

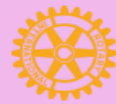
