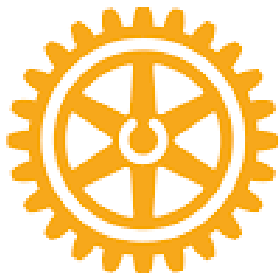

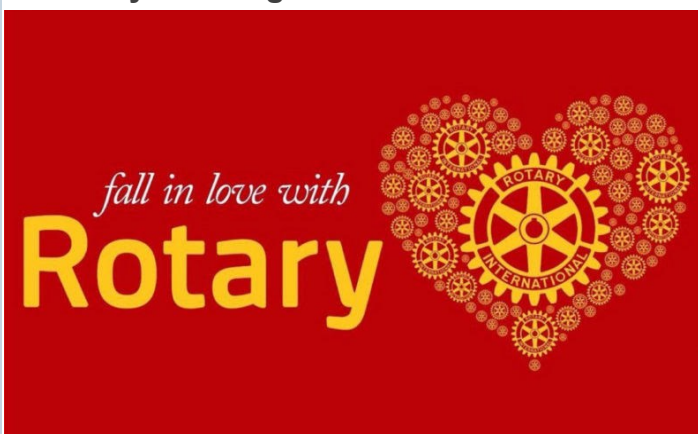
In the spring of 2011, two dozen local families joined forces to accomplish one common goal: To build a sustainable business that would flourish at the
