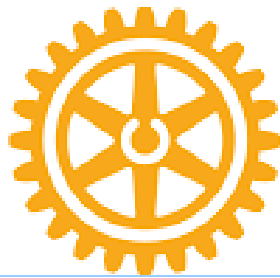

Ron Autrey is the Executive Chairman of Autrey Holdings, LLC. The Autrey Research Division investigates current topics pertaining to environmental health, along with concerns regarding water quality and sustainability of natural resources. Investigation and monitoring of advancements in Desalination Technology and other drinking water production systems is included in the research activities of the Company. Mr. Autrey is past Chairman and CEO of Miller Electric Company. Mr. Autrey is State Certified as an Electrical Contractor and General Contractor in Florida, and several other states. Mr. Autrey is past Chairman of

the State of Florida's Electrical Contractor's Licensing Board. During his leadership, the company expanded into more than 40 States and 3000 employees. Mr. Autrey is a past Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Jacksonville University, with prior membership on the Dean's Advisory Council for the University of North Florida's College of Construction and Engineering. Mr. Autrey is a recipient of JU's Distinguished Alumni Award, and listed in the Top 75 Distinguished Dolphins. He received the UNF Coggin School of Business Distinguished Leadership Award. He was named Citizen of The Year by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office in 2011, and is a member of Florida's Economic Council First Coast Business Hall of Fame.

Mr. Autrey's formal education includes a Bachelor's Degree from Jacksonville University's Davis College of Business. He also attended Western Carolina University and Stetson University before enlisting in the U.S. Army. He received electronics maintenance training in the U.S. Army Security Agency. He received an Honorary Doctorate of Business and Commerce from Jacksonville University in 2012.

Ron Autrey was born in Jacksonville, Florida and currently resides in Ponte Vedra Beach Florida with his wife Hilah Hillyer Autrey who is also a Jacksonville native. They have three children and four grandchildren.
