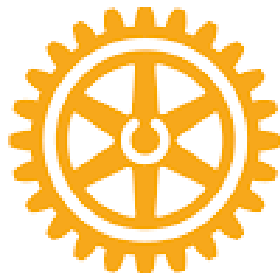

He is a servant leader who always places his faith and relationships at the core of his business and life. He currently directs all projects of the company including High School 9:12, a non-profit initiative committed to the success of Jacksonville-area students in academics, sports and life and a variety of sports events, music festivals and all tourism partnerships.

With more than 28 years as a sports executive, Alan has led and worked some of the nation's largest events including four NCAA Basketball Tournaments, Davis Cup Tennis, Navy vs. Notre Dame

Football game, Gator Bowl, Spartan Races, Florida vs. Georgia Football Game, US Men's and Women's National Team Soccer matches, plus many more.

He has led a variety of sports organizations over the last 17 years, including working as the Senior Associate Athletic Director at Samford University, Executive Director of Sports and Entertainment for the City of Jacksonville, and the Chief Executive Officer of the Jacksonville Sports Council. From 2005-2012, Verlander served as the Director of Athletics at Jacksonville University. During that time, JU athletics enjoyed one of the most successful periods in its history, winning a record 41 championships in different sports, raising more than \$15M to improve athletic facilities and maintaining a student-athletes grade point average in excess of 3.0.

Alan is a graduate of The Bolles School in Jacksonville, where he was a baseball teammate of MLB Hall of Famer Chipper Jones. He also played baseball at Samford University, where he earned a B.A. in Speech Communications, and he later received a Master's Degree in Strategic Communication and Leadership from Seton Hall University. Alan has four grown daughters and one grandson.
