The 2025 tournament will take place at Atlantic Beach Country Club on March 3-8, the week before THE PLAYERS. The Epson Tour is the official qualifying tour of the LPGA Tour, and its mission is to prepare the world's best young women professional golfers for a successful LPGA career. Charlie is a graduate of Belmont University in Nashville, TN and began his career in the golf industry as a club professional. He later went into private business, starting a trade-show exhibit and graphics business in Nashville. He returned to the golf business about five years ago, and in addition to his role at the Atlantic Beach Classic, he also serves as tournament director at the Visit Knoxville Open on the Korn Ferry Tour, the stepping-stone to the PGA TOUR. He also assists with tournament operations at the Korn Ferry Tour Championship at the famed Pete Dye Course in French Lick, IN. Although he works all these events simultaneously, he and his wife of 35 years live in Franklin, TN near Nashville.
