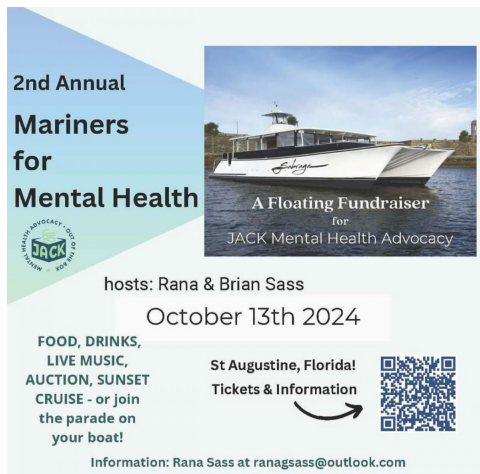

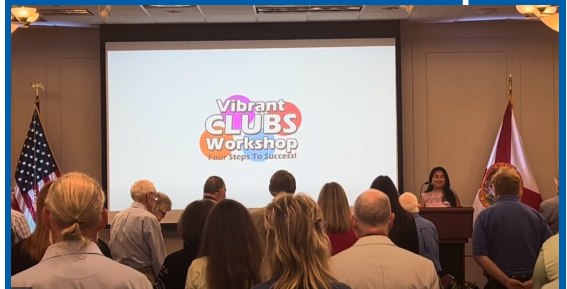

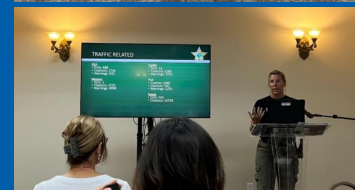

World Polio Day is celebrated each year on October 24th. World Polio Day highlights the global efforts to end poliomyelitis (polio) worldwide. Polio is a life-threatening disease caused by the poliovirus. Since Rotary and its partners launched the Global Polio Eradication Initiative in 1988, the incidence of polio has plummeted by more than 99.9%. from about 350,000 cases to just 5 cases in 2021. **Rotary has contributed more than \$2.4 billion to ending polio.**

Team Sunset will raise funds and awareness for World Polio Day this year, with donations collected during October's club social, social media posts which members are encouraged to share, and with a highlight on 904 NOW in October.
