Riverside Rotary's Nov. 5 program will feature **James Skahn**, district recruitment manager for LifeSouth Community Blood Centers, a non-profit blood bank and the exclusive provider of blood for every Level 1 and Level 2 trauma center in this area. LifeSouth was founded 51 years ago by the Gainesville, Fla. Civitan Club and has since expanded to serve regions in Alabama, Georgia and Florida's First Coast.

Our speaker maintains a full-time commitment to managing his district's donor recruiters and their individual event calendars, assisting with logistics and guiding LifeSouth's public image in the greater Jacksonville, St. Augustine and Putnam County areas. He regularly conducts TV and radio interviews, gives presentations to professional organizations and high schools about blood donation, and networks tirelessly to expand the local donor base.



James personally creates new public campaigns to boost LifeSouth's blood donations. He corresponds with every Level 1 and 2 trauma center in the area as well as the City of Jacksonville to ensure a steady and vital blood supply for north Florida. He takes great pride in knowing his team has helped to save countless lives.

A LifeSouth bloodmobile will be on hand to receive donations in conjunction with our Nov. 12 weekly meeting.
