

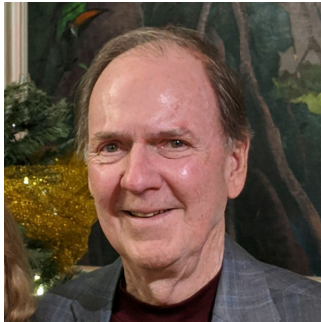

President's Message



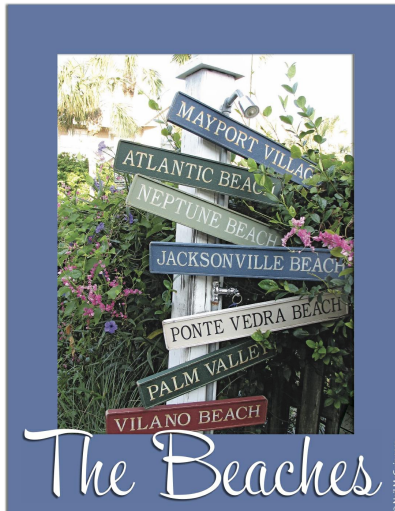
Hello Oceansiders!

This Week's Speaker: Neil McGuinness



Neil moved to Jacksonville with his parents at age 17; attended JU and graduated from the University of Florida. Neil and Kathie married while he was in Marine Officer Training and she was a senior at Hunter College. After serving three years as a Marine Corps officer, he earned his MBA in Finance at the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania.

Neil has had a varied career ranging from he and Kathie owning and operating a 250 passenger paddlewheel riverboat on the St. Johns River to his being assistant to the Chairman and CEO of IBM and later serving as President of Fidelity Investments Employer Services Company. Currently Neil is a board member and Chairman of the SEI Private Trust Company, a national trust company with over \$800 billion in custody assets, and is a full time Realtor with Keller Williams (KW)-

Southside (Jacksonville). Neil and his spouse, Kathie, are a residential Realtor Team and are also part owners of the KW Southside Franchise. Neil served as a Beaches Museum Board Member from 2012-2018. He is also a past Member of Rotary of Ponte Vedra, the Estate Planning Council of Northeast Florida and Semper Fidelis, a USMC veterans group.
