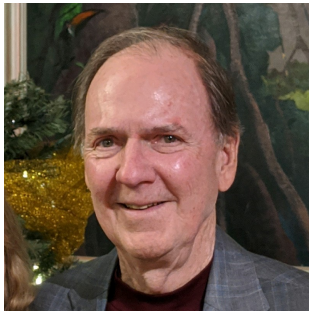

Hello Oceansiders!

First, thanks to all Club members that filled out our Membership Committee's mid-year survey. As soon as we are able to sort through, compile and categorize the results, the Committee will share the results with the club most likely at our Club Assembly on April 16th. Also, thanks to all those that participated in the Rise Against Hunger event at Fletcher High School. In about 2 hours, 27,000 meals were bagged, weighed, sealed, boxed and loaded on trucks to be shipped to those in need.

The Club had reserved funds for an international project that could not move forward due to political unrest in the target country. We have been able to identify several opportunities to use some of those funds: two WASH projects, one in Guatemala and one in Honduras. R.E.V.A.M.P. Duval, is the Registry for Endangered, Vulnerable, and Missing Persons within Duval County.

R.E.V.A.M.P. Duval is a voluntary identification program that aids in the safe return of individuals that may be endangered, vulnerable or missing with cognitive and memory impairment or sensory disabilities. The registry is free to those who apply.

A person qualifying for the R.E.V.A.M.P. Duval is an individual with cognitive or memory impairment, or sensory disabilities who may be at risk for wandering off and require assistance from emergency responders to be returned safely home.
