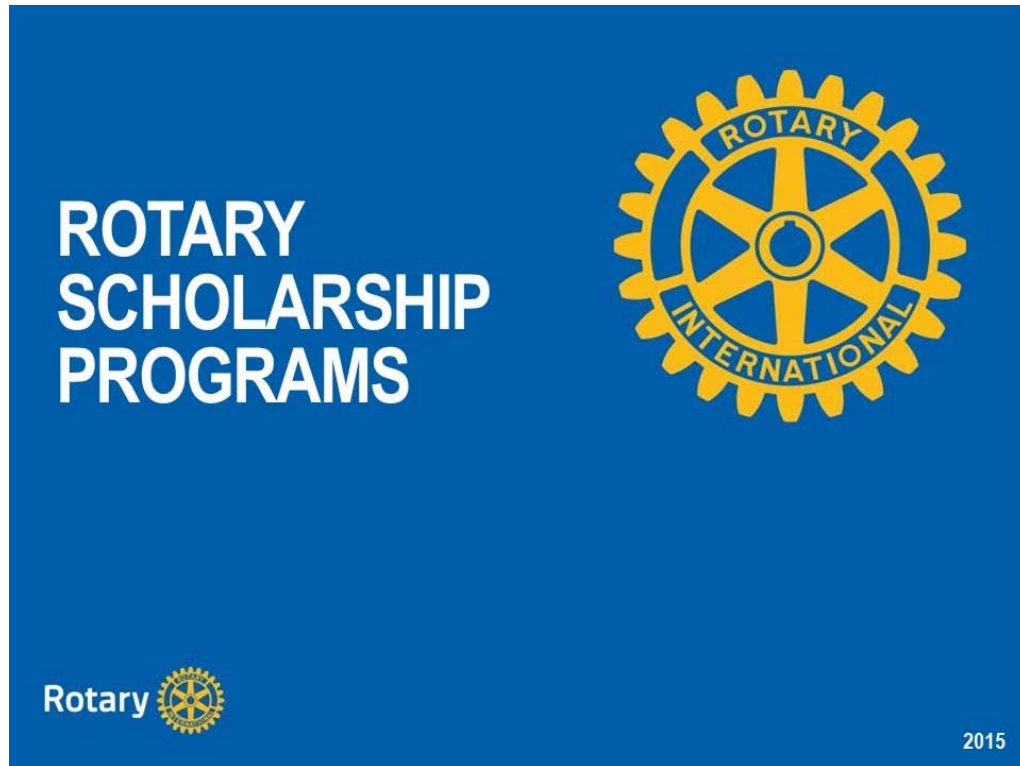

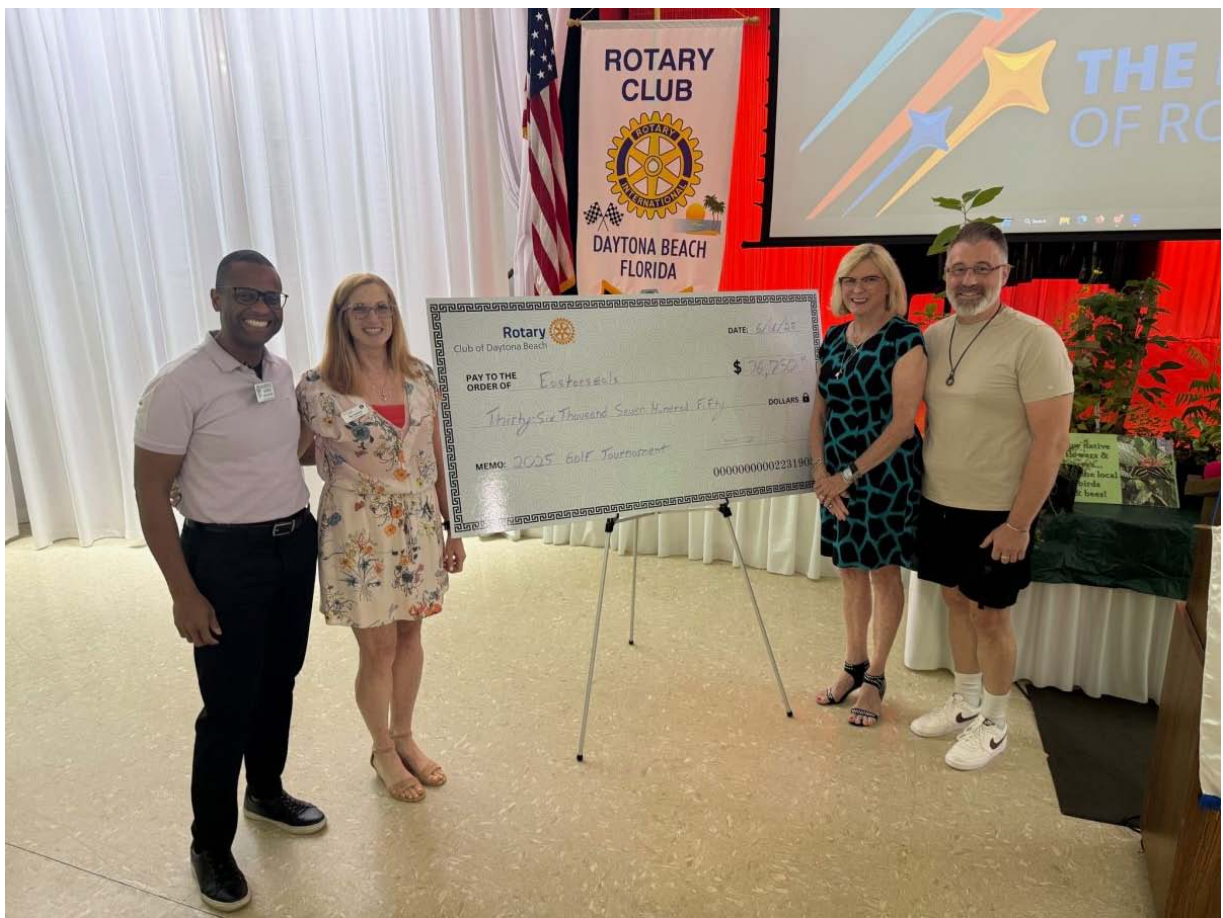


Francesco Arezzo, a member of the Rotary Club of Ragusa, Italy, has been selected to become Rotary International's president for 2025-26.

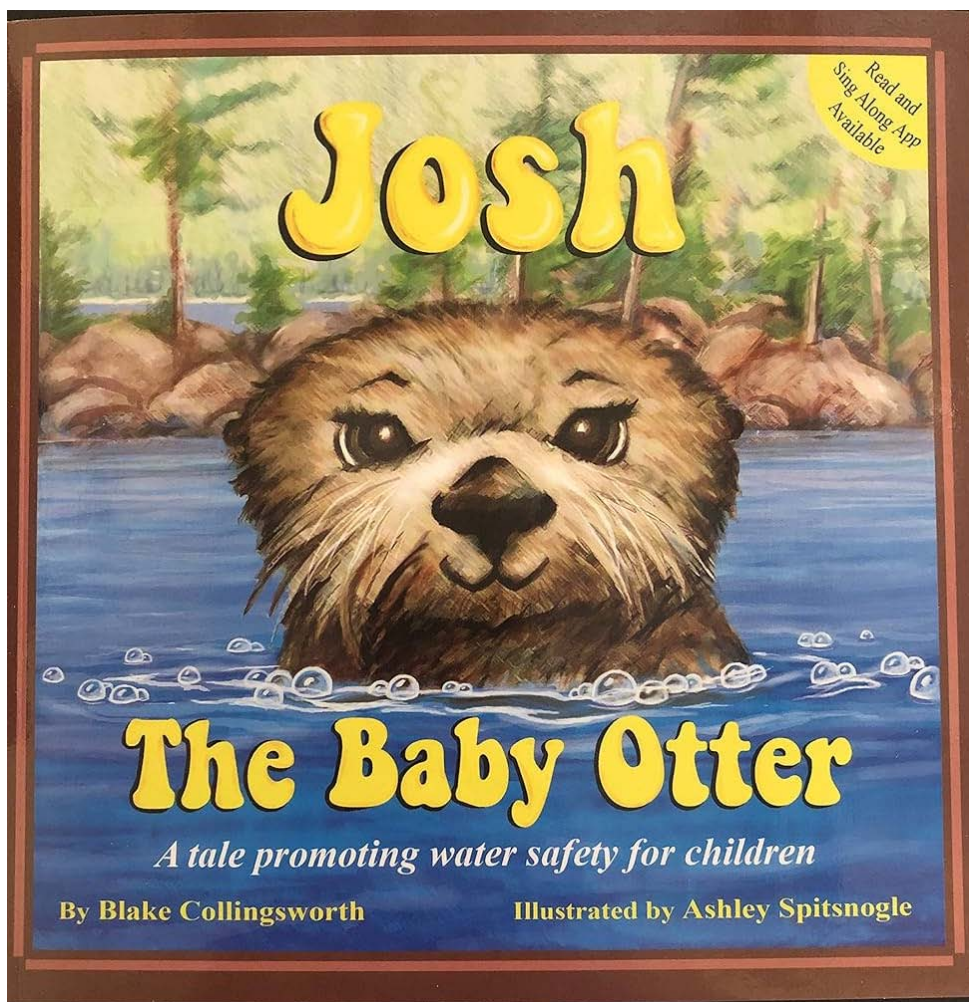
