### Speaker for Monday April 5, 2021 - Katie Lyle, COO of Volusia Flagler YMCA



Born and raised on the shores of New Smyrna Beach, Katie is a lifelong Floridian who spent her life in and around the water. It wasn't until she left sunny Florida that she realized not everyone knew how to swim and that water related deaths, especially in children, are much higher than anyone realizes. After graduating from Daytona State College with an Associate's Degree, Katie moved to Augusta GA to start her career at the YMCA running Aquatics Programs. Teaching both children and adults how to swim quickly became her focus. While managing Augusta's very first YMCA waterpark, Katie finished two bachelor degrees in Criminal Justice and Sociology at Augusta State University, but continued to work for the YMCA and help further their mission in the Augusta area. Katie also trained and certified lifeguards for the American Red Cross during her years at the Y, while moving from an Aquatics Director to Executive Director and eventually Vice President. After a wonderful 12 years of service in GA, Katie moved to Chattanooga TN to further her YMCA career and help another Y and another community flourish. In 2016, Katie was offered the Chief Operating Officer position back in her home town at the Volusia Flagler Family YMCA. Katie knew there was a need she could fill and was eager to come home and get started. Now, over 20 years into her career, Katie is an advocate for non-profits, The YMCA mission and for helping those less fortunate. We all have a duty to act when help is needed. 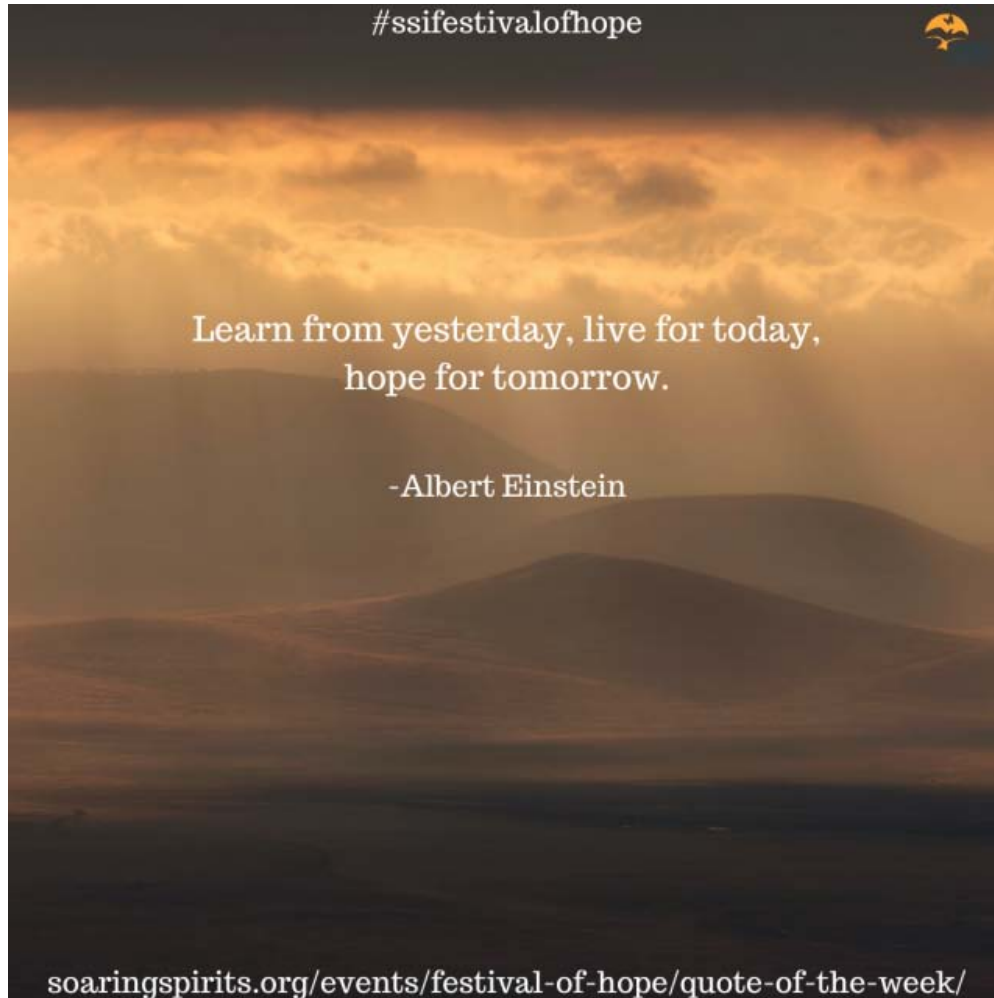
#### Rotary License Plate
