Father Jason currently serves as Rector of St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Daytona Beach, and has been a priest in the Diocese of Central Florida since 2013. Prior to St. Mary's, he served as the Assistant to the Rector at Trinity in Vero Beach. He is a Standing Committee Member, Former Diocesan Board Member.
