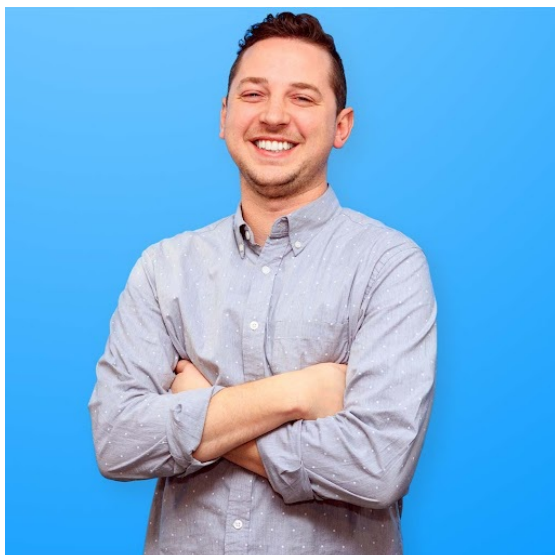

Brent Lager, President

Brent Lager started Uncover KC (UKC) in 2013 to build a bridge between those who want to improve their community and those who need help doing so. Since then, UKC has recruited over 81,000 volunteers and helped them complete more than 208,000 service hours, leading to \$5.2 million in valued impact for local nonprofits. In partnership with the Museum of Arts and Sciences, UKC launched its first affiliate “Uncover Volusia County (UVC)” in the spring of 2024 to begin its national network.

Beyond his nonprofit work, Mr. Lager also serves as an adjunct professor at the William Jewell College Pryor Center for Leadership Development and frequency coordinator for the National Football League. He has a minor in Spanish, a Bachelor’s degree in journalism, and a Master’s of Education in journalism and English from the University of Missouri-Columbia.

Karina Tanner, Director of Volunteer Management

Karina Tanner has over 20 years of experience building high-performing teams that execute retention and growth strategies in the private and public sectors. For more than a decade, she partnered with Fortune 50 companies to provide solutions to local small businesses and give them access to the financial capital and marketing resources they needed.
