**Dr. Elizabeth Hevert, Interventional Radiologist**



Dr. Elizabeth Hevert is an Interventional Radiologist. She performs minimally invasive, image-guided procedures including catheter placement, stenting and angioplasty, tumor embolization, biopsy, spinal pain injections and other nonsurgical treatments.

During her presentation, she'll talk about the minimally invasive outpatient same-day procedure to cure symptoms of benign prostate enlargement. A procedure that is performed all using a small catheter, like an IV, in your wrist!
