Speaker for Monday, August 5 - Kelli McGee, Riverside Conservancy



Kelli McGee is Executive Director of the Riverside Conservancy, a nonprofit organization based in Edgewater that promotes living shoreline restoration and other nature-based solutions to improve water quality and aquatic habitat. Kelli is also President of Natua Strategies, a consulting firm specializing in sustainable business practices and grant writing for corporate and nonprofit clients.

Kelli is a member of the Stetson Institute for Water & amp; Environmental Resilience Board, the Indian River Lagoon Council Management Board, and the Florida Bar. Kelli holds a Juris Doctor degree from the George Washington University Law School in Washington, D.C. where she served as a member editor of the George Washington International Law Review. Kelli earned a bachelor's degree from the University of Virginia, where she double majored in Biology and Psychology.

During her presentation to the Rotary, Kelli will discuss opportunities for cities, businesses, and nonprofits to help restore the health of the Halifax River and Indian River Lagoon, showcase local projects that were grant funded, and share opportunities for Rotary members to get involved.
