Diners and Drive in's Comes to Daytona!

Guy Fieri, John Morgan visit Daytona restaurant for 'Diners, Drive-Ins and Dives' filming

The Mayor of Flavortown has been seen visiting restaurants throughout the Daytona Beach area.

Celebrity chef Guy Fieri and his equally famous spiky blonde hair were spotted at Millie's Restaurant in Daytona Beach Shores after renowned Central Florida attorney John Morgan posted a picture with Fieri on his Facebook page. Dated 6:19 p.m. Tuesday at Millie's, the caption reads: "Filming today for Diners and Drive-Ins... Millie's is the best...had gator ribs and pork nachos."

Despite Morgan's public post, which has been liked by more than 400 Facebook users, Millie's declined to comment on Fieri's visit. Restaurant owner Chris Chibbaro said Wednesday morning that the producers from Food Network, which broadcasts Fieri's wildly popular television show "Diners, Drive-Ins and Dives," requested he not discuss Fieri's appearance until the air date. However, Chibbaro did say that Millie's should appear on an episode of "Triple D" airing "in two to four weeks."

What Daytona Beach-area restaurants did Guy Fieri go to?

Millie's Restaurant and Catering, which offers locally sourced dishes, was recently ranked No. 71 on Yelp's first-ever Top 100 Florida Restaurants list. Millie's will possibly be joined by other local restaurants on the upcoming episode of "Diners, Drive-Ins and Dives."

A private Facebook group focused on Volusia-Flagler restaurants posted a picture of Fieri on Monday in nearby New Smyrna Beach. The caption read, "Guy Fieri at The Garlic and Third Wave! That's as Foodie as it gets." Two of New Smyrna Beach's more popular restaurants, The Garlic and Third Wave Cafe & Wine Bar are located about a mile apart from each other. When I visited on Tuesday, The Garlic declined to talk about Fieri's visit. Third Wave Cafe could not be reached for comment.



Ohio native Fieri, who hosts multiple Food Network shows and owns restaurants across the country, recently bought a \$4 million waterfront home in Lake Worth Beach, which is about a three-hour drive south of Daytona Beach. Fieri's 7.40-square-foot Lake Worth Beach property is located within an exclusive, seven-home gated community near a municipal golf course, according to our sister publication [The Palm Beach Post](#).
