Speaker for Monday, June 10 - Roger B. Handberg United States Attorney



Roger B. Handberg serves as the United States Attorney for the Middle District of Florida. He is a career prosecutor. Mr. Handberg joined the U.S. Attorney's Office in Orlando in 2002. He has served in various senior positions within the office, including as Criminal Chief (North), Chief of the Orlando Division, and Senior Litigation Counsel. Mr. Handberg has specialized in the investigation and prosecution of public corruption and white-collar crime cases. As part of his practice, he has successfully prosecuted more than \$500 million in fraud cases.

After serving for 19 years as an Assistant United States Attorney, Mr. Handberg was appointed to serve as the United States Attorney in an interim capacity in December 2021 – first, by order of Attorney General Merrick B. Garland in December 2021 and then, by the Chief Judge of the United States District Court in April 2022. The President nominated Mr. Handberg for the position in September 2022, and he was confirmed by the United States Senate in December 2022.

Prior to joining the U.S. Attorney's Office, Mr. Handberg served as a Senior Assistant Attorney General in the Economic Crimes Division for the Office of the Florida Attorney General in Tallahassee and as a litigation associate at King & Spalding in Atlanta. Mr. Handberg is a graduate of the University of North Carolina and Harvard Law School.

Did You Know?



Rotary International proudly claims 1.3 million members, and some of them are famous. Such as three Presidents: Woodrow Wilson, in Birmingham, AL; Warren G. Harding, in Washington, DC; and John F. Kennedy, in Hyannis, MA.

A would-be president was a member of the Springfield, IL Rotary Club; U.S. Senator and U.N. Ambassador, Adlai Stevenson. A little further north, Supreme Court Justice Harry Blackmun was on the roster of the Rochester, MN, Rotary Club. That same Rochester Club roster also once included Dr. Charles Mayo, co-founder of the Mayo Clinic.

Two Astronauts were Rotarians; Frank Borman and Gordon Cooper were both members of the Houston Rotary Club. Perhaps taking their cue from one of the original aviators, Orville Wright, a member of the Dayton, OH, Club.

and lest we slight the Navy, Admiral Richard Byrd, of South Pole fame, was a Rotarian in Winchester, VA.



We associate Rotary with business, so it is fitting that Raymond Firestone, founder of the Firestone Tire & Rubber Company, was an Akron, OH, Rotarian, and the legendary retailer, J.C. Penney was a New York City Rotarian. So was Dr. Norman Vincent Peale, the renowned minister and author.

Rotarians have also included artists; Jan Sibelius, the composer from Finland, was a member of the Helsinki Club, and Luciano Pavarotti, the great tenor, was a member of the Modena Club in Italy. Surely, those were clubs that



included singing on their weekly agendas.

Rotarians have even included Hall of Fame baseball players: Connie Mark was in the Ft. Myers Club and Tris Speaker was a member of the Cleveland Rotary Club.

Their names lead one to suggest that if Pete Rose had only followed the Four-Way-test, he would be in the Hall of Fame, too.

FAMOUS ROTARIANS

The "Colonel" Harland Sanders (1890-1966)

The founder of the Kentucky Fried Chicken fast-food empire. In 1919, he was a founding member of the Rotary Club of Independence, Indiana. The Colonel lived on in the 1960s when he was named an honorary member of Rotary until his death in his 76th year. (He also wore a white necktie.)

Henry "Charlie" Chase (1874-1957)

In the 1890s, Henry Chase started as "Charlie Chase" in men from a dress store. He later became a member of the Rotary Club of New York City. In 1917, Chase, an American, was living in England. Henry Chase, working in an office with privilege, he joined the Rotary Club of London and was a member in the year he died (1957). The Rotary Club of London, since 1917, has been a member of the Rotary Club of London.

President John Fitzgerald Kennedy (1917-1963)

The 35th President of the United States of America. He was a member of the Rotary Club of Hyannis, Massachusetts.

President Jimmy Carter (1924-2022)

The 39th President of the United States of America, was, prior to his Presidency, a successful peanut farmer, a small business owner, a state senator, and Governor of Georgia. He was also a Rotarian. In 1966, he was awarded the Rotary International Award for World Understanding.

Elihu "Buddie" Allen (1862-1937)

Founder of the Easter Seal Society dedicated to helping people with physical disabilities. He was first an insurance member, then an active member, of the Rotary Club of Tulsa, Okla. His organization got underway when he organized several Rotary clubs in Tulsa to fund raising to help address the needs of the many children physically disabled by polio. His organization was the first great precursor of the Rotary International Foundation.

Orville Wright (1870-1948)

American pioneer of aviation. Orville Wright was an aviator of the first successful airplane. He also was a member of the Rotary Club of Dayton, Ohio.

Dr. Charles H. Mayo (1861-1939)

Co-founder of the world-renowned Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. Dr. Mayo was a member of the Rotary Club of Rochester, Minnesota and served as its 13th President.

Ernesto "Manny" Quezon (1878-1944)

World champion professional boxer and politician. He was the 11th President of the Philippines.

Admiral Richard E. Byrd (1884-1957)

The famous Arctic explorer, aviator and author. He was a member of the Rotary Club of Washington, Virginia. He is reported that in 1912, Admiral Byrd through his family, joined the Rotary Club of Washington, D.C. He eventually did the same in 1920 when he was in the Navy.

Franklin D. Roosevelt (1882-1945)
