Dr. Fahlberg has a PhD in Clinical Psychology and a Master's of Public Health in International Health from Harvard. She started her clinical career working in the field of child sexual abuse and founded the first graduate program in Brazil, in 1996, on treating abused and neglected children, while also initiating a treatment program in one of Rio's most notorious slums. She later founded a successful non-profit in Lowell, MA which focused on integrating refugees and immigrants into American society. Since 2019 she has overseen the establishment of Daytona Beach's First Step Shelter, where she brings strong leadership, administrative, fundraising, and project management skills. She is a published author and co-editor in the field of domestic violence. She has been recognized as a community leader and was an honoree for Influential Women in Business (Daytona News Journal, Nov. 17, 2022) the Citizens of the Year (Lowell Sun, Jan. 16, 2010), 25 Most Fascinating People of 2009 (Lowell Sun, Dec. 31, 2009), and Women Making a Difference (Lowell Sun, Nov. 4, 2003). Dr. Fahlberg has three children and two grandchildren.

The SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) provides working capital loans to help small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and most private nonprofit organizations of all sizes meet their ordinary and necessary financial obligations that cannot be met as a direct result of the disaster. These loans are intended to assist through the disaster recovery period.
