Speaker for Monday, May 15, 2023 - Krista Goodrich, CEO of Salty Dog Vacations



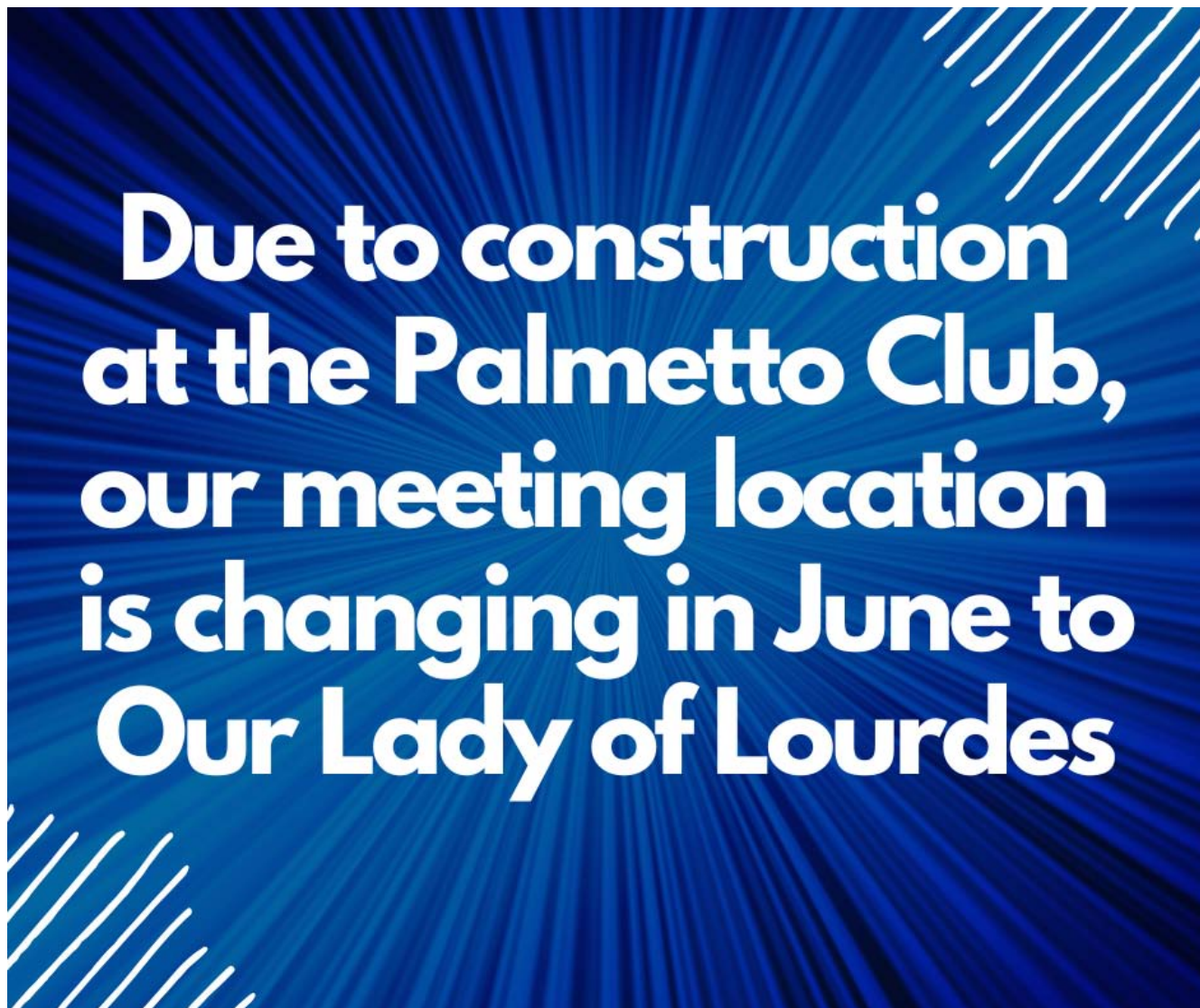

Rotary International News - May 15, 2023

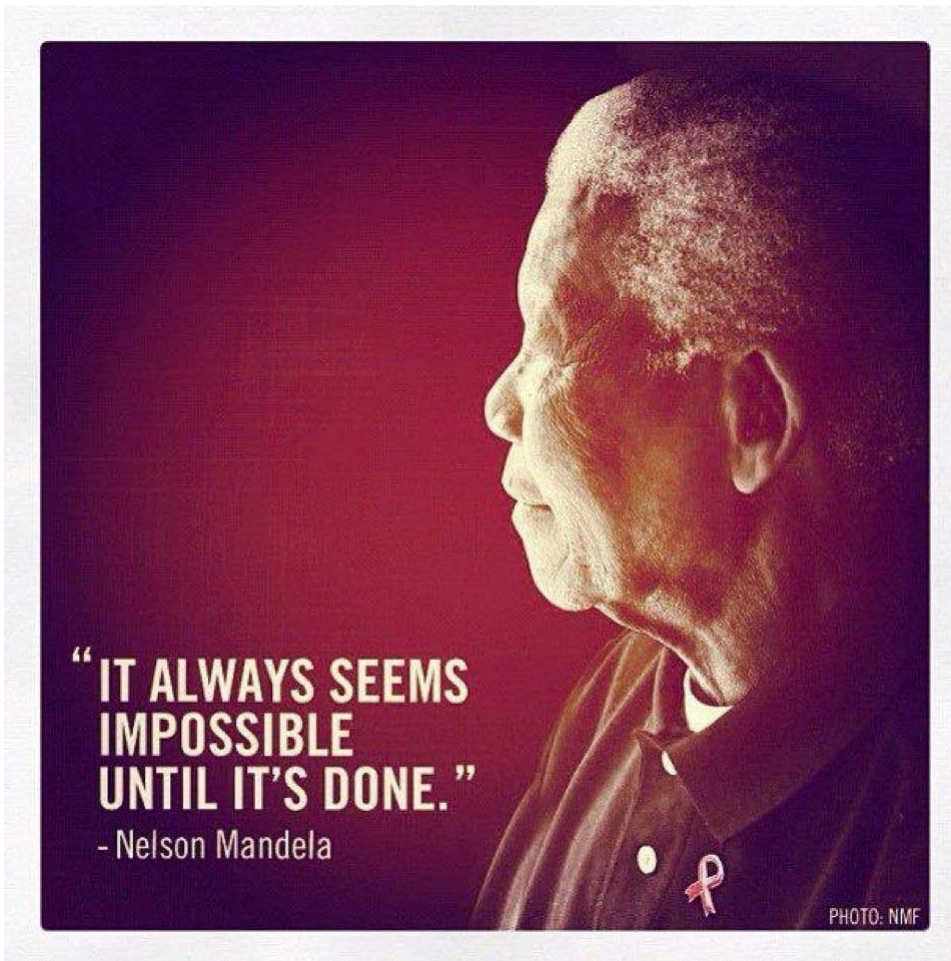
