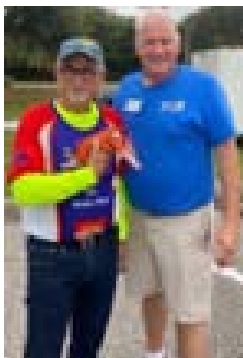


At the Satellite Club of Flagler Beach-Bunnell, President, Nealon Joseph joined me as we inducted Cathy Heigher as a Rotarian.
