After we heard from Julia Kalinsky and James Joeriman at the Vibrant Club Seminar in Palatka, many asked how they can continue to contribute to the District's Ukraine relief efforts.

Monetary contributions can be made to the District York Foundation (501c3). Working with our partner, The Rotary Club of Lviv International, these funds have been used to purchase medical supplies, first aid kits and even a fire engine which is now being used to assist the citizens of Kharkiv, Ukraine. District Rotarians have contributed over \$40,000 to this effort.

Rotary International Ukraine Disaster Relief Grants :

District 6970 Rotarians and the District have contributed \$150,000 to the Rotary International relief effort. Over \$15 million has been collected since Feb. 24 and roughly \$8 million has been distributed to date.

Our District recently participated in a Multi-District effort to purchase and deliver \$175,000 in desperately needed medical supplies.

Our plan is to participate in further grants to assist in local Jacksonville area relief efforts as well as subsequent Multi-District Grant Rounds to purchase medical supplies for Ukraine.

Please consider how you can help. The conflict may no longer lead the news every evening, but the need is clearly great and growing.
