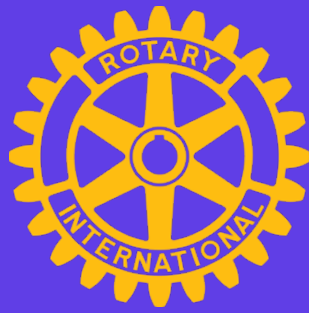

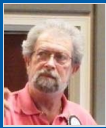

## **Speaker**

**Bobbie Baugh**

Thanked John Kelley worked the tech for Bobbie.

Photo is from South Carolina. Then made a quilt that was designed to capture the journey of her visit.

She loves to photograph windows.

Bobbi chose a set of photographs taken of the Theodore Strawn Orange Packing Plant for a special project. She did her research and wanted to give a voice to the story of the building.



#### Research:

- The Freeze of 1894 – 1895 was devastating to the Orange Production
- 1921 the building burned.
- Bob White were the premier oranges.
- 1993 the building was put on National Register of Historic Places
- Found photographs of the building in use during those times
- Found photos of the people who worked there

#### Creative Process:

Step 1. Photo is on the fabric, which starts out as plain and then has imprinting to give the unique base. imprinted

Step 2. Used some historic photos that represent the people who's lives intersected at this place. That is a very important element

Step 3: Bobbi sketched the images of the people to be added to the design.

Step 4: Print photos onto the fabric. Made images of oranges. Use wheat paste to create the images. Added Green for color dimension.

Step 5. Used natural forms. Put them on the printing plate. Pressed them in to get the form.

Step 6: Added words to have text in the quilt to help tell the story

Added more images.

Painted them in black on the muslin to create the images of people.

Finished Piece Called "Is Like A Day Without Sunshine." You may remember the song sung by Anita Bryant to advertise orange juice. Art Quilt 30 inches X 50 inches

Art, History and Government – commissioned to do this piece. You can see her winning submission on display on the southside of the city hall.

Questions:

How many hours does it take to create something like this? 6 – 8 weeks If you want a commissioned piece, please allow a couple of months.

Your background as a teacher – did you use the Socratic method? Bobbi. Art is about something and Everyone sees something different when they look at it. Artwork needs to be ambiguous to communicate.

Bobbi is a Graduate of Stetson. She developed her interest in Art Quilting when she learned that it is a recognized Art. Studio Art Quilting. Bobbi enjoyed studying forensic art and had Double major in Art and Speech. As a little school we competed nationally. Learned to speak (by practicing 20 hours a week).

A lot of people come to Deland to do the Art Walk. Georgia tells that the most widely distributed piece is the handout about the Art Tour Brochure. . Amanda also commented on how wonderful the Miniature Art Walk is for children.

Bobbi serves on the Mural Art Committee – This became important to the artists to ensure that the Art is representative of the artistic community. If you want to put a mural on your building submit a request. Procedure to follow. Michael Orr is also on the committee. Meet when a mural is proposed.

Ben complimented the art he acquired during a past Wild Game Feast which no hangs in his office.
