On behalf of the hundreds of children who will receive vital surgery that will give them a new face and a new future, THANK YOU!

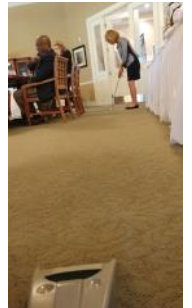
