May 14th, Bernie Grossman, Ph. D., Our Technological Future

Bernard M Grossman, Ph.D. is a professor emeritus and was formerly professor and department chair of Aerospace and Ocean Engineering at Virginia Tech for more than 25 years. His research specialty was computational fluid dynamics. He has lectured widely in the US, Europe, and Asia.

Early in his career, Mr. Grossman worked at Grumman Aerospace in the research department when the Apollo Lunar Module and the F-14 were being designed and built. He was also a founder and vice president of education at the National Institute of Aerospace. He occasionally teaches graduate level classes in aerospace engineering at the University of Florida. He is a Fellow of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics.

Mr. Grossman is currently retired and lives in Nocatee, where he has a variety of interests including teaching adult education classes in future technologies. He is also one of the founders and current president of the Jewish Genealogy Society of Northeast Florida. He is a former president of Ponte Vedra Beach Toastmasters.

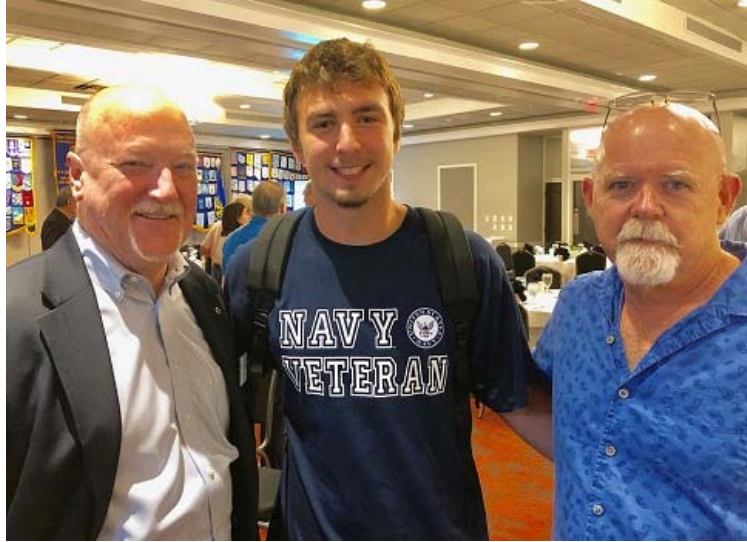
Laughs for Charity Report
