Senator Aaron Bean, October 1

Aaron Bean was first elected to the Florida Senate in 2012. He was subsequently re-elected without opposition in 2014, 2016, and with opposition in 2018. He is currently serving as chair of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services. He also served a term as chairman of the Duval County Legislative Delegation in 2018. Before being elected to the Florida Senate, Aaron served eight years in the Florida House of Representatives.

Aaron was tapped by then-Speaker of the House Marco Rubio to chair the House Health Care Committee, which oversaw all health care policy and the appropriations for approximately one-third of the state budget. Prior to being elected to the Florida House in 2000, Aaron served as a commissioner and mayor of the City of Fernandina Beach and was named **Best of the Best** by the Fernandina Beach News-Leader.

In 2018, Aaron was named **Legislator of the Year** by the Florida Guardian ad Litem (GAL) Foundation for his unwavering commitment to GAL and to abused, abandoned and neglected children. He was also named **2018 Legislator of the Year** by the Florida Dental Association and a **Delores Barr Weaver Elder Advocate** by ElderSource.

In addition to serving as president of Compass Bank in Nassau County for 11 years, Aaron has successfully launched four small businesses, including the High Energy Auction Company. He has been a professional Florida auctioneer for more than 18 years, and his quick wit and impressive results have put him in high demand as an auctioneer throughout the state of Florida.

Aaron received his Bachelor of Science in Finance from Jacksonville University and is currently the relations development officer at UF Health Jacksonville. He has been a Rotarian for 26 years and a volunteer for numerous organizations, including the National Alliance for Mental Illness, the YMCA, Crime Stoppers, and Nassau County Schools. Aaron and his wife, Abby, reside in Fernandina Beach, Florida and have three sons: Bradley, Gray, and Walker.

rJSO Asstant Chief Paul Restivo

JSO Assistant Chief Paul Restivo is the Zone 3 Commander in charge of patrol. He has 200 officers with whom he covers the 150 square miles from the St Johns River on the west and Beach Boulevard on the north to the St Johns County line in the south and east. It is a large and very busy area.

Assistant Chief Restivo said that he uses the data from crimes reported in the sector to determine officer deployment each week. He also stressed that he is flexible and can redeploy manpower as needed. He reassesses the data daily.

There were 210 incidents of crime reported in Mandarin over the last 180 days. 20 arrests were made. Most of the incidents were cleared or exceptionally cleared. The area in Mandarin with the greatest number of crimes during this period was 11111 San Jose. The highest number of crimes occurred between the hours of 3PM and 5PM. Assistant Chief Restivo said that Mandarin is mostly quiet after dark.
