Dr. Rosenblatt began his discussion with some information about Global Climate Trends. He discussed the increasing CO2 concentrations and how that is causing Global Warming. He then went on to describe how that is projected to affect the Jacksonville area. Because the ocean is heating, it will cause flooding in coastal areas. He described the economic impact that Global Warming will have on Jacksonville. Jacksonville will be the most expensive area to protect from flooding with seawalls. We are likely to see more intensive hurricanes with greater rainfall.

He then told the group what they could do to help. He discussed H.R. 763 called the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act. It is supposedly a bipartisan climate solution, but he said only one Republican has signed on to it. He is encouraging our members to write to Congressman Rutherford and express support for the bill.

The bill essentially imposes carbon taxes on fossil fuels to reduce their use but drives up cost. The taxes collected on the fuel will then be distributed back to the people with a small amount being retained for administration. This redistribution will offset the increased cost.

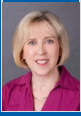

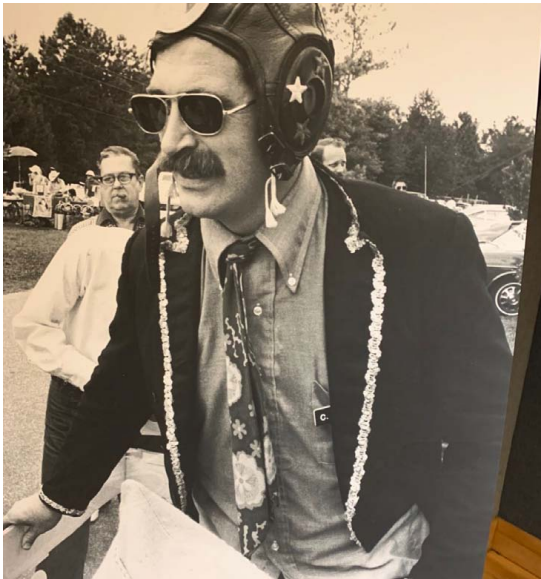
