Warner selected [Community Hospice of Northeast Florida](#), which had provided service to his parents as well as his wife, as the beneficiary of the event.

The first event was held April 6, 1996, at [Ritz-Carlton](#) Amelia Island. Warner assembled a group of 163 cars and attendance was around 2,200.
