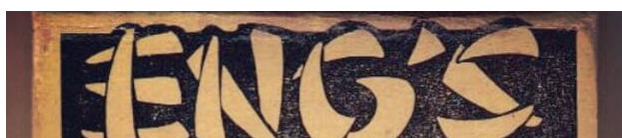
About Blue Bamboo

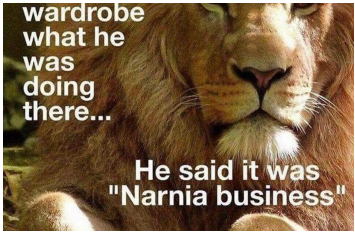
