### The Deliberative Voice



The purpose of The Deliberative Voice is to share the value and methods of the deliberative process for upper elementary through high school classrooms, university curricular and co-curricular settings, faculty development, and communities where citizens seek to address local issues in a reasoned and inclusive manner. Contrasted to debate, where two opposing viewpoints compete, and distinctly different from conversation for the sake of becoming better informed, deliberative democracy helps people move from sharing their respective opinions to making collective choices or judgments with others by weighing strengths and corresponding challenges or drawbacks of a series of potential "problem-solving" actions.

The Deliberative Voice will:

- Introduce the basics of deliberative democracy and dialogue.
- Teach deliberative forum moderation techniques.
- Help university faculty use deliberative inquiry and dialogue in the classroom
- Incorporate deliberative inquiry and methods in educational and community planning.
- Illustrate deliberative applications in faith community settings.
