Eastman has completed three operational Maritime Patrol and Reconnaissance tours, deploying multiple times to the 5th, 6th, and 7th Fleet areas of responsibility in support of Operations: Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, Unified Protector, and Inherent Resolve. He served with the "Grey Knights" of Patrol Squadron FOUR SIX (VP-46) as a junior officer and the VP-5 "Mad Foxes" as a department head. Returning to the Grey Knights in 2016, he was privileged to serve as executive officer then 82nd commanding officer, leading the squadron during a quad-site deployment to Bahrain, Djibouti, Turkey, and Okinawa. During this tour, the Grey Knight team won the 2017 and 2018 Battle Efficiency awards as well as the 2017 and 2018 Golden Wrench awards for maintenance excellence.

Afloat, Eastman served aboard USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN 71) as a Catapult and Arresting Gear Officer, completing work-ups and a 5th Fleet deployment in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

His shore assignments include: Fleet Replacement Squadron Instructor at VP-30; Action Officer for the Combined Joint Special Operations Task Force at Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan; Operations Officer at Task Force 57 in the Kingdom of Bahrain; Integrated Air Defenses Branch Chief at Joint Functional Component Command for Global Strike, U.S. Strategic Command; Operations Officer and Deputy Commander for Task Force 72 (CTF-72), Battle Director for the 609th Combined Air Operations Center in Qatar, and he completed Joint Professional Military Education Phase II at the Air War College.

Capt. Eastman has flown over 2,800 hours in the P-3C Orion & P-8A Poseidon. His decorations include the Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Air Medal, Navy Commendation Medal (with valor), and the Association of Naval Aviation's 2003 Navigator of the Year.

He has been married for 33 years to the former Diane Beedle of Anaheim, California and they have a daughter Dana, and three sons Dillon, Daniel, and David.
