This week in Rotary, even though we did not have a lunch meeting, our club and its members have been busy! Ten of us made the decision to attend the Vibrant Clubs Seminar hosted by the district. We had 9 of our members attend the event. It was great to see folks out on a Saturday learning more about Rotary and what we can do as Rotarians to have an impact in our communities and our clubs.

The second board meeting of the year was also conducted this past week. First, let me thank all of you for your engagement in the well-being of our club; 78% of our members responded to the budget survey. After reviewing the responses and the corresponding comments, the board is recommending an increase in dues of \$160 annually for active members and \$40 annually for R85 members. This covers the increase in dues from both RI, the District, for active members. This recommendation of the board will be voted upon at our next lunch meeting during the business portion of our agenda. Treasurer Ryan, Vice President John, and myself will be meeting to revise our budget assumptions and get an approved budget in place for this Rotary year. I am very proud to be a part of a board that is so engaged and looking out for the best interest of the entire club membership and our club's future. Making decisions like this can be difficult. A few great long strategies have also been presented to keep our club financially viable well into the future. More to come on this as ideas are developed into action plans.

Last but definitely not least, our social at Volunteers in Medicine (VIM), [Our Story | Free Medical Clinic, Jacksonville, FL | Volunteers In Medicine Jacksonville \(vimjax.org\)](#) sponsored by Bacardi was just simply fabulous. The new facility is so thoughtfully laid out for its patients and volunteers. CEO Jennifer Ryan was so hospitable and informative. She conducted tours of the facility herself, shared the VIM story and history and also shared a great video with us highlighting the patients they serve.
