## Welcome Dr. Pella - October 15 2019

Our speaker this week is Pablo M Pella, M.D., an Internal Medicine/Infectious Disease Specialist in Jacksonville, Florida. Dr. Pella attended the Universidad de Panama School of Medicine, graduating with honors in 1985. He completed his Internal Medicine Residency at Lincoln Hospital Bronx, NY and his Infectious Diseases Fellowship at New York Medical College in Stamford, CT.



Dr. Pella has been practicing in Northeast Florida for nearly 3 decades in the inpatient and outpatient settings. He has participated in humanitarian medical mission trips throughout his career, providing direct care, medical supplies and clinician education throughout the Americas. In 2011, Dr. Pella and his colleague Ivan Guerrero, MD co-founded HOPE Across the Globe, an international medical and case management 501(c) (3) organization serving the needs of people living with infectious diseases and the impact they have on daily life both in NE Florida and Latin America.

Although Dr. Pella treats patients afflicted with the spectrum of infectious diseases, he is particularly passionate about helping people afflicted with/at risk of Hepatitis C and HIV. He has been a life-line for providers and patients in impoverished areas of Central and South America affected by Hepatitis C and/or HIV. His work and contributions positively reduce the incident of Mother-Infant Transmission of HIV, changing life expectancy for the infants from 2-4 years after birth to normal ranges.

Dr. Pella lives in Ponte Vedra with his wife Lisa, an Advance Practice Registered Nurse, and their children. In his free time, he enjoys travel, reading and family time.

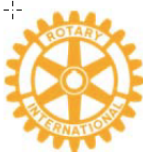

## This Week in History

1931

Capone goes to Prison

On this day in 1931, gangster Al Capone is sentenced to 11 years in prison for tax evasion and fined \$80,000, signaling the downfall of one of the most notorious criminals of the 1920's and 1930's.

Alphonse Gabriel Capone was born in Brooklyn, New York, in 1899 to Italian immigrants. He was expelled from school at 14, joined a gang and earned his nickname ♦Scarface♦ after being sliced across the cheek during a fight. By 1920, Capone had moved to Chicago, where he was soon helping to run crime boss Johnny Torrio♦s illegal enterprises, which included alcohol-smuggling, gambling and prostitution. Torrio retired in 1925 after an attempt on his life and Capone, known for his cunning and brutality, was put in charge of the organization.
